
Francis, now adorned in glory, friars minor honor you.



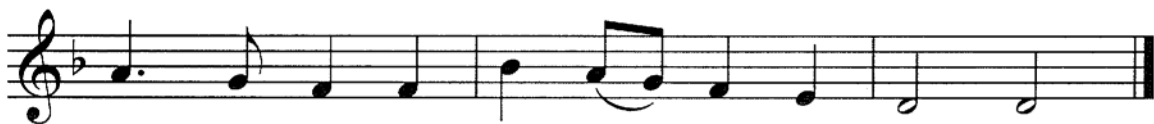
